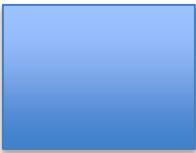

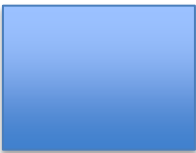

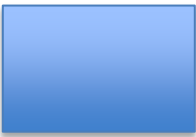

- The nominee must not be serving in or actively running for a partisan office.
- The award recipient must allow recognition in the LWVD website and other publications.
- Complete nominations must be received by **September 15, 2017**, to be considered.
